For so you ordained when you created me, saying: 'Dust you are and to dust you shall return.' All of us go down to the dust, yet weeping at the grave, we make our song: Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia.

*All:* **Give rest, O Christ, to your servant with the saints: where sorrow and pain are no more, neither sighing, but life everlasting.**

Following the reading of names recorded in the St. Paul's burial register, we invite you aloud or in the silence of your hearts to name those whom you remember.

*Presider:* Hear us, O merciful Father, as we remember in love those whom we have placed in your hands. Acknowledge, we pray, the sheep of your own fold, lambs of your own flock, sinners of your own redeeming. Enfold them in the arms of your mercy, in the blessed rest of everlasting peace, and in the glorious company of the saints in light.
